### DEAR FELLOW ARTS SUPPORTERS,

I am thrilled to report that the past year has been a whirlwind of growth and creativity at the Carroll County Arts Council! In a year that could have been characterized by upheaval, there was a smooth transition in leadership and we expanded our signature events, presented a variety of fabulous exhibits, and continued to offer the same high caliber programming that you have always enjoyed from us.

One of our proudest accomplishments in the past year was to facilitate the installation of "Sprouts" by Thomas Sterner. This beautiful new public sculpture at the corner of John and Main Streets in Westminster was funded by a grant from the Maryland State Arts Council and the City of Westminster. If you haven't driven by it, please do so! Additionally, we celebrated our 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Festival of Wreaths, had a record-breaking 12<sup>th</sup> Annual PEEPshow in April, displayed 8 exhibits in our galleries, and produced 47 concerts and programs in our theatre.

Operationally, we looked excitedly to the future. The board undertook a strategic planning process that reiterates our mission and gives us 3 strategic initiatives, complete with goals and action items. The strategic plan will inform how we better serve all our constituents in the next year. We tightened up policies, figured out new procedures, and ordered some much-needed office equipment, including something unique to our "office," a new slushy machine for the concession stand.

As rewarding as the past year has been, this next year promises to be even more exciting. We have introduced a season pass and are planning for our 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary. Mark your calendars for our Solid Gold Celebration, Sunday, October 27, a fundraiser for a much-needed theatre renovation. Through a generous matching grant from the Heart of the Civil War Heritage Area, we will be raising \$60,000 to upgrade our stage, paint and re-carpet the theatre, and get new lights and curtains so that we can attract richer, more diverse programming content.

As always, we couldn't do what we do without the ongoing support of you, our wonderful members! As we look optimistically to the future, we value more than ever your participation as volunteers, board members, donors, sponsors and members. You are the true stars of the Carroll County Arts Council, and we appreciate you! Take a bow!

# highlights | Visual Arts

## Exhibits

As always, our three galleries were full of noteworthy exhibits. Some of the highlights were: "Synergy," featuring 3 Carroll County artists creating dynamic works in 3 media all using vibrant and provocative colors; the Gallery of Gifts, our indoor holiday art sale; and the Carroll County Camera Club's exhibit of travel photographs. We featured Youth Art Month, as well as "Elements," an exhibit that showcased artists working in the four elements of earth, air, fire and water. The Four County Quilters Guild created an exhibit "Inspired by Pearls," and Carroll County Artists' Guild featured a wide variety of works in multiple media. We completed the year with "Rock, Paper, Scissors," an intimate exhibit that showcased works of sculpture and German paper-cut artwork called "scherenschnitte."

## Children's Classes and Camps

We had multiple successful sessions of art classes for kids ages 5 through 12. A variety of teachers from Carroll County Public Schools shared their talents with our students and brought a fresh set of skills to our classes. Additionally, we helped find teachers for The Boys and Girls Club's art club. With all these activities, we continue to bring creative outlets to a significant number of kids in Carroll County.

## Summer Camps

Summers at CCAC mean art camps! During our 2 weeks of camps, the building hums with creative energy from our budding artists. There's never a dull moment as the approximately 50 children create their personal masterpieces.

## Bus Trips

Our patrons enjoyed 2 visual arts bus trips this past year. The first was to the Virginia Museum of Fine Art to view the collection and the enhancement of works of art by local and regional Garden Clubs. The second trip went to Philadelphia to view the ever popular Through the Impressionist Eye.

Our fabulous annual events and fundraisers attracted more than **60,000** visitors to Westminster. We strive to continue to improve these events with new ideas and better organization.

### 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Festival of Wreaths

November 29 -

December 8, 2018

Artists donated 165 wreaths and we raised over **\$22,700**. Our new 'seal the deal' price option was a hit.

### yArt Sale

August 18 & 19, 2018

Generous donors brought us thousands of used artworks and art supplies. We sold these items yard sale-style and raised over **\$5,080**. Our new 'pay what you want' discount on the second day was a great success.

### PEEPshow

April 12-23, 2019

Our talented candy artists entered a total of 162 fabulous marshmallow masterpieces using more than 38,000 PEEPS®. The show attracted 28,000 visitors from 45 of the 50 states and several foreign countries! We raised over **\$86,300**.

### Art in the Park

June 6, 2019

Beautiful weather attracted 62 vendors and thousands of shoppers to our annual outdoor arts festival.

### Bus Trips

This past year our patrons enjoyed bus trips to 2 fabulous productions: *Twelve Angry Men* at Ford's Theatre in Washington, D.C. and *West Side Story* performed by the BSO at the Meyerhoff Symphony Hall

### Concerts

We had a variety of concerts this past year, including some Arts Council favorites as well as some fresh faces. We once again featured the popular John Denver cover artist, Chris Collins. Other return acts were the Scottish folk band North Sea Gas and the ever-popular jazz stylings of the Eric Byrd Trio. New to the Arts Center stage this year was the world-renowned Beijing Guitar Duo and the traditional instrument quartet, Wherligig.

### FLICC

Most CCAC films are chosen by a volunteer committee called Film Lovers In Carroll County (FLICC). FLICC screened 15 films last year, including the popular Documentary Series and Foreign Film Festival. ## Scholarships

### \$9,960 IN SCHOLARSHIP ALLOCATION

- **Tevis College Arts Scholarship.**

One senior at each local high school received an award to attend college with an arts major

- 7 awards / \$7,000 total

- Recipients attending schools in California, Florida, Maryland and Georgia.

- Majors: Graphic Design (x3), Studio Art, Photography, Theatre Design and Production, and Apparel Business Management.

- **Tom Holder Memorial Scholarship.**

Students in need may receive free or reduced tuition for CCAC education programs

- 15 student recipients; \$1,985 of class/camp tuitions waived

- \$975 spent toward art teachers for Boys and Girls Club classes.

## Grants

### 23 TOTAL GRANTS FOR \$54,300

- **Community Arts Development (CAD) Grants.**

Large annual awards to support the operations of local arts organizations

- 13 grants; \$49,000

- Recipients attended a professional development workshop on social media engagement led by Ryan Nicotra, Assistant Director of the Annual Fund and Digital Engagement at MICA.

- **Arts in Education Grants.**

Small awards to support arts experiences in education settings

- 6 grants; \$2,975

- Over 1600 total students benefited from activities supported by AiE grants.

- **Mini-Grants.**

Small awards to support projects not fitting into other categories

- 4 grants; \$2,325

- Including support for the Carroll County Artist Studio Tour, and the Players on Air production of *Little Women*.



## Outreach

### Musical Instrument Bank.

We accept donations of old or unused musical instruments, repair and then distribute them, so they can be used by students in need.

We had a surplus and were able to donate **38 instruments** to the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra's OrchKids program. From the OrchKids Facebook page, "As our program grows, we are excited to give these instruments a new home!"



## CAD grant recipient testimonials

### ◀ DOWNTOWN SYKESVILLE CONNECTION

The DSC was awarded grant funds to turn urban fixtures to art pieces in downtown Sykesville. This project allowed the DSC to solidify relationships with several artists that were contracted [the previous year]. The Downtown Sykesville visitors' response to the art projects during creation showed an overwhelming excitement in the community.

### MASTERWORKS CHORALE OF CARROLL COUNTY

The Carroll Council Arts Council (CCAC) has been very supportive of Masterworks Chorale of Carroll County (MCCC). They have provided consultation regarding both the Carroll County and Maryland State Arts Council grant processes, as well as being extremely helpful promoting MCCC concerts. They have also offered programs to assist arts organizations; most recently CCAC offered an excellent guest speaker who addressed developing and expanding art organization social media outreach.

### CARROLL SINGERS

In June of 2018, Carroll Singers selected a new artistic choral director to replace Beverly Gandolfo who resigned from that position. Our new director is Julia Richard, choral director at Westminster High School.

Carroll Singers began using social media advertising last year to seek new members and to advertise our Winter and Spring concerts. We were able to maintain and slightly improve our membership during the 2018-2019 concert season.

Our CAD grant last year provided us the opportunity to expand the use of guest or auxiliary musicians for our programs. This provided our audience with an opportunity to experience additional support to the sound of our choral programs.

### ◀ ENCORE COMMUNITY MUSIC ASSOCIATION

With the help of the CCAC CAD grant program, the Encore Community Music Association is able to institute more digital marketing to gain greater visibility. We have also expanded the Homeschool Academy to include two additional locations this year.




